## Gallery Outlook: New Awning, New Space(?)

The City of West Chicago has agreed to remove the wooden overhang at Gallery 200 and replace it with a fabric awning similar to those on many of our neighbors' storefronts. Bids have been reviewed and **LuAnn Bombard** hopes to see the finished banner in place by October 1. "We just need to select the colors," said **LuAnn**. "Black with thin vertical gold stripes looks to be a popular choice." The City is funding expenses for the project.

LuAnn also advises that the City is looking into refurbishing our basement, which will require that the facility be made ADA-compliant. If this is a "go," the Gallery could have access to the basement for studio space. Given the increasing popularity and variety of class of-

ferings, this would be helpful in increasing our visitor throughput. Remember the old saw about becoming an "overnight" sensation, but taking 20 years to get there? We persevere!

LuAnn has also been updating our member phone and e-mail address lists. The current lists are at the front desk; please check your listings and correct if necessary!

Lastly, in the July newsletter, we advised members that canvas shades for the upstairs windows has been procured, and invited members to submit designs to be juried. 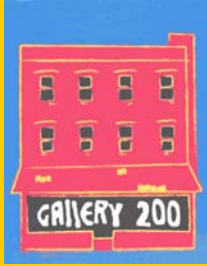
